



## Biography – Delma Rodríguez



**Delma Rodríguez** is director of Latin America-Europe Cultural Ring in Uruguay, from 2011 to date. She designed the project for which Uruguay became a new official node to the ring. This project aims at creating, accessing and democratization of quality content in arts, science, technology and society in local and global advanced Internet networks. For example: "Uruguay visits CERN", "(Neutrinos and +)" connection with ALMA, experimental concerts and then from the National Auditorium for more than 30 nodes, among others. Thus, in the Ring of Uruguay during these years many different institutions have been integrated, such as universities, cultural centers, schools, high schools, auditoriums, museums, among others. In this way Anilla Uruguay has allowed direct participation of more than 20,000 people in the country, integrating diverse populations together with specialists and national benchmarks that have interacted with other international peers. In this framework coordinates activities and projects between Latin America and the Caribbean, Europe and North America.

She is the creator and coordinator of "InfoArt project" on education interaction, ICT, museums, since 2002. From 2007 to the end of February 2015, part of the educational project InfoArt was in public education (promoting research in teacher training and secondary education), in order to encourage the creation of educational innovation projects, linking teachers and students in contexts of art, technology and content of museums, cultural centers, among others.

In 2012 she was partner at WEYA, a British organization that convened the first world meeting of young artists held in the framework of the Cultural Olympics, which accompanied the London 2012 Olympic Games.

She has served as researcher to the project "Pedagogical practice in innovative learning environments", 2011-13, funded by the Organization of American States OEI, A Coruña County Council, Education Training Council of Uruguay, among others.

Due to her work in education and museums she has been summoned by the Ministry of Education and Culture of Uruguay to integrate the Latin American Technical Committee Award in Education and Museums Ibermuseos (Technical Unit in Brasilia), in its editions 2010, 2011, 2013 and 2014.

She was selected to join the program "Training Leaders for the Next Generation Internet" 2014, ISOC - Internet Society.

In 2015, she organized a several sessions by videoconferences to promote and engage new audiences in IG Internet Governance. In the sessions has participated the most important references on IG at Latin America and The Caribbean and UE. For example: Rodrigo de la Parra VP ICANN, Sebastian Bellagamba CEO ISOC LAC, Shernon OSEPA ISOC, Alejandro Pisanty ICANN-ISOC-UNAM, Olga Cavalli SSIG-ICANN-ISOC, Cristina Monti y Christer Hammarlund (European Commission) and among others.

She has a Bachelor of Science degree in Education (research option) and Teacher Education degree in Visual Communication and various postgraduate and master's degrees in Education, Technology and the Arts, forming a multidisciplinary profile. For example: Masters in Visual Arts and Education - University Girona, Barcelona, Granada; Master Process Technology Mediated Education (ongoing thesis project) - National University of Cordoba; Diploma in Education, Images and Media - FLACSO of Buenos Aires; Graduate Program in Medial Arts – UNCórdoba.

Works as a teacher in postgraduate and graduate degrees such as: Diploma Curated of Art, Art Project course - Visual Culture Foundation and University of Our Lady of La Paz in Bolivia (2013 to present); degree courses Image Theory and Theory of Visual Arts – at IPA Teacher Training Institute "Artigas", Montevideo (2005 to date).

She has published articles in National and International editions on issues of new media, education, advanced Internet networks, ICT, innovation, projects, arts.

Since 2002 she works as an organizer, speaker, and exhibitor in congresses at national and international events.
